4-6 weeks after the Site Visit	Await the Decision letter	 Pen a Decision Letter based on the results of the Review Panel and communicate decision to the birth center If accredited, an accreditation certificate is mailed, and the birth center is listed as "Accredited" on the CABC website
90 days after receipt of Decision Letter	Complete Progress Report addressing requirements outlined in the Decision Letter	Review Panel conducts a review of the Progress Report and requests additional documents if necessary
After Progress Report is received	 Submit any revisions or additions to the Progress Report as requested by the Review Panel 	Communicate the final decision to the birth center
1-year after the Site Visit	 Look ahead to next year: If the starting point is 1-Yr Accreditation, anticipate the 1-Yr Review Site Visit If the starting point is 3-Yr Accreditation, anticipate the first Interim Status Report. 	Alert the birth center when it is time to complete the Interim Status Report or begin preparing for reaccreditation.
